

Waste Management Strategy

As environmental issues are getting more and more attention, waste management is a materially topic that global corporations have to face. In order to reduce the environmental impact of waste, Eclat committed to the following guidelines as the highest guiding principle for waste management:

1. Comply with the local waste related laws and regulations

Comply with or even exceed the relevant waste laws and regulations to meet customer needs or local community's expectations.

2. Sort waste, and increase reuse rate

Reduce waste production by reusing package, focus on green production development by using the recycle material.

3. Optimize wastewater treatment and reduce sludge

Optimize the wastewater treatment system and adjust the optimal operating parameters to reduce the use of treatment chemicals and sludge.

4. Replace landfill or incineration treatment with reuse treatment

The waste disposal principle is treated as the primary method by entrusting qualified reuse manufacturers. If there is no suitable treatment route, it will be buried or incinerated as the final treatment.

5. Eliminate high-risk waste treatment manufacturers, implement waste assessment and evaluation systems

The waste treatment manufacturers must operate after the evaluation is qualified; renew the contract after annual evaluation which confirms the manufacturer's processing capacity and potential risks.
